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Transitional Kindergarten


- Qualifying Age: 4 years old the entire school year, may turn 4 by September 1st.
 Qualifying birthdates - September 2, 2020 -Sept 1 2021
- Transitional K is the 1st year of a 2 year program (TK year 1, Reg K year 2)
- Focuses on Kindergarten readiness skills:
 - Social-emotional development
 - Learning through play
 - Oral language development
 - Phonemic awareness
 - Developmentally appropriate play and learning skills





Kindergarten

- All incoming Kindergarteners will be assessed within a few weeks of school. These assessments focus on academic skills (letters/sounds, number sense, etc).
 - The first two weeks of Kindergarten are planned/paced by the Kinder team of teachers. This allows for flexibility/change if needed!
- Transitional Kindergarten is required for students turning 5 years old between 9/2-6/2.
- Transitional Kindergarten is an option for young 5 years old born between 7/1 to 9/1. Assessments may be done prior to placement based on parent request. If you are interested request TK upon enrollment.

 Work Completion Requirements
 - Edgenuity SIS Program
 - Combination of online assignments with supporting workbooks
 - Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science
 - Mandated weekly scheduled check-ins on Google Meet with FUESD credentialed teacher
 - Small group and reteach opportunities throughout the week (optional) facilitated by credentialed teacher

Registration

- Kindergarten Registration:
 - Registered birth certificate/Baptismal certificate
 - One proof of residency (utility bill, etc.)
 - Immunizations
 - Oral health exam
 - Physical exam no sooner than March 2023
- Intradistrict/Interdistrict Transfers (August)
 - If your interested in a school of choice you must complete an intradistrict transfer request to your school of residence.
 - All transfers are based on SPACE AVAILABILITY
 - Registration is NOT first-come, first-served.
- Registration must be done through online registration portal

Registration Online Only

Must be complete prior to start of school

Will be accepted from Now to August, then ongoing

Immunizations should be completed and uploaded

Oral Exam/Physicals must be complete prior to the start of school


Immunizations

- On the 4th birthday, TK students shift to K-12 Immunization Tracking Schedule
- If your child will be 3 when they start TK please see your school nurse now
- Please make appointments for your child to have their 4 year immunizations now
- On your child's 4th birthday they need the following immunizations: Polio, DTaP, MMR, Varicella to meet school requirements


